**Reminders:** *This is a great journey we are embarking on together, and I am excited for the possibilities. The keys to success is that we as the parent and the teacher are partners in helping the child learn and grow. We just don't want the kids enrolled in lessons, we want them to succeed in lessons and achieve at a high level, which all kids can do. For parents that have not had a instrumental experience prior, understanding the longevity of seeing this growth can be new. In general it will take about a year before the magic starts to happen. Staying in piano lessons for all of childhood/teen years, is not likely for most kids, but to have them leave this experience with a sense of really understanding what it is like to play, I suggest being able to make a commitment until they complete book II. Completing book II takes about 3-4 years of study, depending on the age of the child. Of course, there is no need for a 3-4 year commitment today! Today, just please note that lessons are scheduled and billed out one month at a time. If you need to miss a lesson, 24 hour notice is required in order to schedule a make up lesson. I also strongly suggest that you are able to make a commitment for about a year in order to reach lift off. This commitment not only means bringing the child to lessons each week, but practicing with them at home 3-4 times a week, and listening to the reference recording at home or in the car about 6 times a week. For the first lesson you need to bring the Suzuki Piano School book I and have the recording which goes with it. For convenience sake, I have some of these for sale at \$22.50 each. With these steps in place, I am certain we will have a fun and rewarding experience.*
